BANQUET HALL

The Banquet Hall is a bright, semi-circular space adorned with Takaka marble on the lower walls and columns. Located in the Beehive, the large space and stunning ambiance make it the perfect venue for gala dinners and formal receptions.

HISTORY OF THE ROOM

The Banquet Hall was designed as the first function space in Parliament, big enough to hold state banquets. The first event held here was on the 28th of February 1977, when Queen Elizabeth II officially opened the Beehive.

GRAND HALL

Refurbished in the 1990's, the 27-metre long Grand Hall has magnificent architecture, arched stained-glass windows and stained-glass ceiling domes.

HISTORY OF THE ROOM

Located near the Chamber, the Grand Hall served primarily as the Members' Lounge, providing a space for members to play billiards and socialize, particularly during late or all-night House sessions.

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL CHAMBER

The Legislative Council Chamber is a grand space boasting a magnificent puriri canopy, elegant Italian marble pillars and rimu paneling. An ideal space for cocktail and theatre-style functions.

HISTORY OF THE ROOM

Between 1853 and 1950, New Zealand's Parliament included a second chamber, the Legislative Council (Upper House), consisting of appointed members with the primary role of amending or rejecting bills passed by the House of Representatives.

The Legislative Council Chamber's most important role today is as the venue for the State Opening of Parliament after each general election.

GALLERIA

The Galleria is an elegant venue with soaring glass ceilings and polished marble floors. It is perfect for intimate gatherings and small-scale corporate functions.

HISTORY OF THE ROOM

The Galleria is a revitalized area that was created during extensive renovations of Parliament House from 1992 to 1995. During this refurbishment, an open courtyard, which extended into the basement and underground car park, was enclosed and modernized to create the Galleria.

Today the Galleria features a multimedia artwork by Malcolm Harrison – ‘These are Matters of Pride,’ which was commissioned for the Galleria in 1996. It creatively represents New Zealand’s landscape and the migration of Polynesian peoples.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

How do I get there?

Parliament is within 10 minutes walking distance of the Wellington Railway Station and bus stops on Lambton Quay and Molesworth Street. The main entrance into Parliament is located between the Executive Wing (Beehive) and Parliament House.



Is there parking available?

There is no parking on the Parliamentary grounds. Metered parking is available on the side streets around the Parliamentary grounds. Visitors with mobility access requirements may be set down on the forecourt. The driver must remove the vehicle from the forecourt as soon as the drop-off or pick-up is complete.

Do I have to go through security screening?

All visitors to Parliament buildings are required to undergo security screening. The screening process provided by the Parliamentary service security team helps maintain a safe and protected environment. If you require any assistance with the security screening process, please ask one of our security officers for assistance.

Can I take photos?

You may take photos inside your booked function venue.

What am I not allowed to bring to Parliament ?

Parliament is a non-smoking venue, inside and outside, including the immediate areas around the main entrance. The following prohibited items must not be brought to Parliament:

- Flammable liquids or accelerants (e.g., petrol, diesel, CNG, and LPG)
- Weapons or other equipment that could cause harm
- Items that produce flames or extreme heat (including candles and cooking appliances)
